# FOOTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KHAALIQ BURROUGHS • Wesley College Junior • Quarterback • Palmyra, NJ/Paul VI

Burroughs becomes the second different Wolverine to earn NJAC Offensive Player of the Week honors after helping No. 22 Wesley remain unbeaten in conference play with a 49-0 NJAC win over Southern Virginia. In Wesley's home opener, he completed 79 percent of his pass attempts, finishing the game 15-for-19 for 181 yards and three touchdowns. He also contributed on the ground with four carries for 14 yards and a rushing TD. Burroughs currently ranks second in the NJAC in pass efficiency (170.0).



### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

DARIN HUNGERFORD • Kean University Senior • Linebacker • Dumfries, VA/Forest Park

Hungerford earns NJAC Defensive Player of the Week honors for the second consecutive week after registering the most solo tackles by an NJAC player in the game this season during Kean's 18-15 NJAC road defeat at Montclair State. He tallied 15 total tackles in the contest, including 13 stops, 2.0 tackles for a loss, and 2.0 sacks. With his second 15-tackle game of the season, Hungerford has now produced the two highest single-game tackle totals this season. He currently leads the NJAC in total tackles (13.2 per game).



## SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**HUNTER DALY • Montclair State University Junior • Punter • Neptune, NJ/Neptune** 

Daly earns NJAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for the second straight week after propelling the Red Hawks' to an 18-15 NJAC win over rival Kean. With four field goals made in the game including a 41-yarder with 6:32 remaining for the winning score, he became the first MSU player with four or more FGs made in a contest since 1997. He also contributed in the punting game by averaging 42.5 yards on five attempts, including three which were downed inside of Kean's 20-yard line. Daly currently leads the NJAC in both punting average (41.9) and field goals made per game (1.25).



#### OFFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

MARCQUAN GREENE • Wesley College Freshman • Running Back • Chestertown, MD/Kent County

Greene becomes the third different Wolverine to earn NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week honors after helping No. 22 Wesley remain unbeaten in conference play with a 49-0 NJAC win over Southern Virginia. In his first collegiate game played, he averaged 12.5 yards per carry, finishing the day with 50 total yards on just four attempts. His 27-yard fourth quarter run currently stands as the second longest run of the season by a Wesley player. The selection of Greene marks the third consecutive week that a Wolverine has garnered NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week honors.



## DEFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

STEFON WOODRUFF • Wesley College Freshman • Defensive Line • Bear, DE/St. Georges Tech

Woodruff earns NJAC Defensive Rookie of the Week honors for the second time this season after helping No. 22 Wesley post its third consecutive shutout with a 49-0 NJAC win over Southern Virginia. In his first career game played at Scott D. Miller Stadium, he tallied five total tackles, including three solo stops. He also garnered 3.5 tackles for a loss and 1.5 sacks to help Wesley remain unbeaten in conference play. Woodruff currently ranks tied for second in the NJAC in sacks (6.0).
