### **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**TREVOR OSLER** • The College of New Jersey  
Senior • Quarterback • Marlton, NJ/Cherokee

Osler earns NJAC Offensive Player of the Week honors after leading the Lions to their first victory of the season, a 20-14 NJAC road win at rival Rowan. He completed 25-of-32 pass attempts for a career-high 340 yards and three touchdowns in the victory. The 340-yard performance marks the most passing yards by an NJAC player in a game this season. His 79-yard first quarter touchdown pass to Thomas Koenig also represented the second-longest pass completion by an NJAC player this season. Osler currently ranks second in the NJAC in passing yards per game (221.7).



### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**KEVIN STOKES** • Rowan University  
Junior • Defensive End • Mays Landing, NJ/Oakcrest

Stokes earns NJAC Defensive Player of the Week honors for the second time this season after leading the Rowan defense in its Homecoming defeat to NJAC foe TCNJ. He registered six total tackles, including five solo stops and 4.5 tackles for a loss. He also notched 2.0 sacks which resulted in a loss of 21 yards while also blocking a Lions' 28-yard field goal attempt early in the contest. His 4.5 tackles for a loss are the second most by an NJAC player in a game this season. Stokes currently leads the NJAC in total tackles for a loss (15.0).



### **SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**NICK BRUHN** • Wesley College  
Sophomore • Kicker/Punter • Burke, VA/Lake Braddock

Bruhn earns NJAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for the second consecutive week after helping No. 14 Wesley remain unbeaten in conference play with a 29-9 Homecoming NJAC win over Kean. He was 2-for-2 on field goal attempts, connecting on kicks of 40 and 46 yards apiece. He also was 3-for-3 on extra point attempts while also averaging 38.0 yards on three punts. Bruhn currently ranks tied for the conference lead in field goals made per game (1.17).



### **OFFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

**MALCOLM FACEY** • Frostburg State University  
Freshman • Running Back • Randallstown, MD/Western Tech

Facey earns NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week honors after helping the No. 18 Bobcats improve to 5-1 overall with a 59-7 NJAC road win at William Paterson. In just the fourth game of his collegiate career, he averaged 8.0 yards per carry, finishing the game with career-highs of nine rushes for 72 yards. He also ran for his first career touchdown in the fourth quarter just six plays after a career-long 41-yard run on the first play of the series. Facey currently ranks tied for 28th in the NJAC in rushing (18.5 yards per game).



### **DEFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

**JAKE BROSCHART** • Frostburg State University  
Freshman • Linebacker • Fulton, MD/Atholton

Broschart earns NJAC Defensive Rookie of the Week honors after helping limit the host Pioneers to just seven points and 162 yards of total offense in Frostburg State's 59-7 NJAC road win at William Paterson. In just the third game of his collegiate career, he tallied a team-high and career-high eight tackles, including four solo stops. He also registered a pair of pass break-ups to help the Bobcats secure their fourth NJAC victory of the season. Broschart currently ranks tied for 10th in the NJAC in passes defended (0.67 per game).
