TRACK ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

ASPEN McMILLAN • Rowan University
Junior • South Brunswick, NJ/South Brunswick

Returning two-time all-conference performer Aspen McMillan earns the first NJAC Indoor Track Athlete of the Week honor of the 2017-18 season after a strong performance at the Lehigh Season Opener in Bethlehem, PA. She competed in the 60m hurdles and 60m dash, placing third and fourth respectively in those events and first among Division III competitors. She clocked a 9.13 in the hurdles, which ranks first in the NJAC and fourth nationally. She also posted an 8.08 in the 60m dash, which ranks 33rd in Division III so far this season.



FIELD ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

AMBER EDWARDS • Ramapo College
Senior • Sayreville, NJ/Sayreville

Returning All-American Amber Edwards picks up the first NJAC Indoor Field Athlete of the Week award of the 2017-18 season after her performance at the TCNJ Indoor Opener at the 168th St. Armory. She posted the nation's best triple jump of the season so far with a mark of 11.75m and qualified for ECACs in the process. She also posted a personal best time of 9.32 seconds in the 60m prelims, and placed second in the finals with a time of 9.37 seconds.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

PROMISE FADAHUNSI • Rowan University
Freshman • Jamesburg, NJ/Monroe Twp.

Fadahunsi earns the first NJAC Rookie of the Week honor of the 2017-18 season after a strong collegiate debut at the Lehigh Season Opener in Bethlehem, PA. She competed in both the long jump and 60m dash, posting the nation's eighth-best mark in the long jump (5.43m). She is also tied for 37th nationally with her time of 8.10 seconds in the 60m dash.
