SWIMMER OF THE WEEK

QUINN REYNOLDS • William Paterson University
Junior • Delran, NJ/Delran

Reynolds earns NJAC Swimmer of the Week honors after helping the Pioneers secure a pair of meet victories during a five-day span. In an NJAC win over Kean, she produced first-place finishes in both the 50 freestyle and the 100 backstroke events with respective winning times of 26.66 and 1:04.41. Four days later in a non-conference road win at Brooklyn, she claimed first-place showings in both the 50 freestyle (26.76) and the 100 backstroke (1:03.35). She also competed as a member of WPU's first-place 200 freestyle relay (1:52.49). The winning performance by Reynolds in the 100 backstroke currently stands as the 15th best conference time in the event this season.



DIVER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore • Linwood, NJ/Mainland Regional

Lawler earns NJAC Diver of the Week honors for the second time this season after helping WPU improve to 8-1 on the season with a 103-83 non-conference road win at Brooklyn. She claimed a first-place showing in the one-meter diving competition with a winning score of 178.50. Lawler also secured a first-place finish in the three-meter event with a winning score of 184.50.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Freshman • Paterson, NJ/Passaic County Tech

Santos becomes the second different Pioneer to earn NJAC Rookie of the Week honors after competing in the Pioneers' meet victories over Kean and Brooklyn. In the NJAC win over the Cougars, she produced first-place showings in both the 100 freestyle (59.87) and the 200 individual medley (2:37.18). Four days later at Brooklyn, she placed first and second place finishes respectively in the 100 freestyle (59.95) and the 50 freestyle (27.53). The runner-up performance by Santos in the 50 freestyle currently ranks as the 37th best conference time in the event this season.
