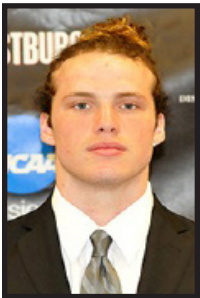

### **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**KHAALIQ BURROUGHS** • Wesley College  
Senior • Quarterback • Palmyra, NJ/Paul VI

Burroughs earns the final NJAC Offensive Player of the Week selection, his second of the season, after leading the Wolverines to a 42-34 road win over Westminster in the ECAC Clayton Chapman Bowl. In the final game of his collegiate career, he completed 18-of-27 passes for 219 yards and two touchdowns. He also was a factor in the run game by gaining 51 yards on 10 carries with three rushing touchdowns. Burroughs, who was named MVP of the ECAC Bowl after accounting for five TDs in the victory, currently leads the NJAC in passing yards (270.0 per game).



### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**JAKE BROSCHART** • Frostburg State University  
Sophomore • Linebacker • Fulton, MD/Atholton

Broschart earns the final NJAC Defensive Player of the Week selection after helping the Bobcats improve to 10-0 with a 42-24 victory over Western New England in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. He registered a season-high 11 tackles in the victory, including eight solo stops and 4.5 tackles for a loss. He also notched a sack, a pass break-up and a pass defense in the win which propelled Frostburg to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second straight season. Broschart is one of three different NJAC players to record a league-best 4.5 tackles for a loss in a game this season.



### **SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**NICK BRUHN** • Wesley College  
Junior • Kicker/Punter • Burke, VA/Lake Braddock

Bruhn earns the final NJAC Special Teams Player of the Week selection after helping Wesley close its season with a 42-34 victory over Westminster in the ECAC Clayton Chapman Bowl. He wrapped up his junior campaign by going a perfect 6-for-6 on PAT attempts. He also was a factor in the punting game after averaging 37.0 yards per punt on three attempts. Bruhn currently ranks seventh in the NJAC in punting average (35.0).



### **OFFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

**HUNTER CLEAVER** • Salisbury University  
Freshman • Wide Receiver • Walkersville, MD/Walkersville

Cleaver earns the final NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week selection this season, becoming the third different Sea Gull to claim the honor. In the first postseason game of his collegiate career, he recorded his first career reception during Salisbury's 14-7 defeat to Alfred in the ECAC Asa S. Bushnell Bowl. Cleaver, who played in eight games for Salisbury during his rookie season, finished as one of nine players to record a reception for the Sea Gulls this year.



### **DEFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

**JALUND JOHNSON** • Wesley College  
Freshman • Linebacker • Brandywine, MD/Gwynn Park

Johnson earns the final NJAC Defensive Rookie of the Week selection this season after helping Wesley secure a 42-34 ECAC Bowl win at Westminster. In the first postseason game of his collegiate career, he garnered a career-high 10 tackles in Wesley's comeback victory. One of four different Wolverines to register double-digit tackles in the season-ending win, Johnson finished his freshman campaign with 20 total tackles and one pass break-up.
