JACK ANDERSON • Christopher Newport University Junior • Quarterback • Great Falls, VA/Langley

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Anderson earns NJAC Offensive Player of the Week honors for the second time this season after leading CNU to a 39-6 NJAC road win at Rowan. He completed 24 of 37 passes for 313 yards and five touchdowns. His five scoring strikes were to five different receivers, and he became just the second Captain player in program history to pass for five touchdowns in a game. Anderson, who became the first NJAC player to throw for five TDs in a game since November 12, 2016, currently leads the NJAC in passing yards per game (261.5).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NAZIR WILLIAMS • Wesley College Sophomore • Linebacker • Bridgeton, NJ/Bridgeton

Williams earns NJAC Defensive Player of the Week honors after helping the No. 6 ranked Wolverines improve to 4-0 overall with a 28-7 NJAC road win at Southern Virginia. In Wesley's first road contest of the season, he tallied a team-high 12 tackles, including three solo stops. He also garnered a tackle for a loss, a forced fumble, and two pass breakups in a defensive performance which saw Wesley hold the SVU offense scoreless for the final three quarters of the game. Williams currently leads the NJAC in forced fumbles (2).

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CORTERRIS SIMPSON • Wesley College Junior • Punt Returner • Waldorf, MD/Lackey

Simpson earns NJAC Special Teams Player of the Week honors after helping No. 6 Wesley remain unbeaten with a 28-7 NJAC road win at Southern Virginia. He averaged 42.3 yards per punt return on four attempts, including an 80-yard fourth quarter touchdown for Wesley's final points of the game. He also contributed offensively with 12 yards from scrimmage on one rush and one reception. Simpson currently leads the NJAC in punt return average (35.1).



OFFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

LONDELL MONTGOMERY • Salisbury University Freshman • Running Back • Fort Meade, MD/Meade

Montgomery becomes the second different Sea Gull to earn NJAC Offensive Rookie of the Week honors after helping Salisbury improve to 4-0 on the season with a 42-0 NJAC road win at William Paterson. In the first action of his collegiate career, he averaged 5.3 yards per carry, finishing the contest with 16 rushing yards on just three attempts. Montgomery was part of a Salisbury rushing attack that gained 471 total yards on the ground in the victory.



DEFENSIVE ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

CHOZEN DAVIS • William Paterson University Freshman • Defensive Line • Atlantic City, NJ/Atlantic City

Davis becomes the second different Pioneer to earn NJAC Defensive Rookie of the Week honors after leading his team in solo tackles during WPU's defeat to Salisbury. In just the fourth game of his collegiate career, he registered a career-high six tackles, including five solo stops. He also notched a career-high 2.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks, marking the second straight home contest in which he has garnered a sack. Davis currently ranks tied for third in the NJAC in total sacks (3.0).
