Trenton State Background: In his first season at TSC, Steve Ware was the team's No. 2 ground-gainer behind Joe Clifton. He totalled 363 net yards and 67 carries for an average of 5.4 per play, scoring six touchdowns. His season's best performance came in the wild 53-51 loss at Pace, when he ran for 106 yards on 12 carries, good for three TDs. He also netted 100 yards on eight carries in a 17-14 win over Western Connecticut. Hamilton is expected to experiment with Ware, an all-around running back, at the fullback slot.

Secondary School Background: Ware was a starter for the football, baseball and basketball teams at Woodstown High School, winning "All-South Jersey" honors as a halfback and centerfielder. He originally enrolled at Division II Millersville University.

Personal Background: The younger of two children, he is the son of Clinton and Barbara Ware of Woodstown. He will decide his major at TSC this fall.

Trenton State Background: Mike Wargo is expected to be a starter as an outsider linebacker for the third consecutive year. He appeared in nine games last season and picked up 30 tackles, to go along with two fumble recoveries and an interception. He had six stops against Wagner and Pace. "Mike has the ability to be a solid Division III player," said Hamilton. "He's continued to work hard to develop his strength to go along with that ability." In 1986, he earned ECAC "Honor Roll" recognition with his performance in a loss against Glassboro State.

Secondary School Background: Wargo is a product of nearby Notre Dame High School in Lawrenceville, where he participated in both football and track. He was a starting linebacker for coach Charles "Chappy" Moore there and starred his senior year, when the Irish won the New Jersey Parochial "A" title.

Personal Background: The second oldest among four children, he is the son of Gerald and Lorraine Wargo of Trenton. Majoring in health and physical education.

Trenton State Background: Craig Wigley is coming off an injury-filled 1987 season but is being counted upon to play a complete season. "When healthy, Craig is the hardest hitter on the defense," notes Hamilton. Wigley, who had nine tackles in a loss to Montclair State, won second team "All-New Jersey Athletic Conference" honors as a sophomore. He recorded 51 tackles that season and was one of the team's top defenders.

Secondary School Background: Wigley played both football and baseball at Rancocas Valley Regional High School, captaining the former as a senior. He played five different positions during his scholastic football career and was selected to play in the North-South All-Star Classic in 1983.

Personal Background: The son of James and Joanne Wigley of Mt. Holly, he is the fourth oldest among six children. A vice president in the Phi Alpha Delta fraternity at TSC, he is majoring in technology education.
