# **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

MADDIE BRAY • Rowan University Junior • Attack • Medford Lakes, NJ/Shawnee

Bray earns her first NJAC Offensive Player of the Week award of her junior season after leading Rowan in its season-opening win over Ursinus. She drained six goals - including the game winner - on nine shots. Three of her scores came on free position attempts. She also scooped up six ground balls, caused one turnover, and earned two draw controls. Bray is currently tied for fourth among all NJAC players in points (6) and is tied for second in goals (6).



### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

BRITTANY BALLACK • Kean University Senior • Midfield • Monroe Twp., NJ/Monroe Twp.

Ballack picks up her first NJAC Defensive Player of the Week honor after leading Kean to a seasonopening win over Old Westbury. The midfielder caused four turnovers and scooped four ground balls in the win, while helping the Cougars limit Old Westbury to just two goals on seven shots in the 19-2 win. She also contributed on the offensive end with three goals including the game winner. She is currently tied for second in the conference with her four caused turnovers.



### **ROOKIE OF THE WEEK**

#### JESSICA CATALIOTO • Stockton University Freshman • Defense • Ringwood, NJ/Lakeland Regional

Catalioto earns her first career weekly honor as the NJAC Rookie of the Week after helping Stockton to two wins to open the 2018 season. She led the team with 10 draw controls and tied for the team lead with three caused turnovers in her first two collegiate games. She recorded six draw controls and three caused turnovers in her collegiate debut against Widener. She added four more draw controls in the second win over Albright. She currently ranks tied for second among all NJAC players with her 10 draw controls, and is tied for fifth with three caused turnovers.
